Transport yourself to the 1920s. A visit to the Burnaby Village Museum has something for all ages.

A visit to the Burnaby Village Museum is a step back in time to the 1920s. Experience life as it might have been in Burnaby. Self-guided tours let you discover the farmhouse and village at your own pace. Period-costumed townsfolk welcome you and give demonstrations at the various homes, businesses and shops of a traditional village along the BC Electric Railway tram line. A traditional BC Electric Railway tram stop village has been created with a combination of heritage and replica buildings on a 10 acre site. Be sure to explore the newly restored Interurban Tram and take a whirl on the fully restored historic 1912 CW Parker Carousel.

Burnaby Village Museum offers many historically themed school programs for students attending Kindergarten up to Grade 7. All programs are designed to complement the BC Social Studies curriculum.

### Fridays 6:30pm - Saturday 9:00pm

Come brave the night in the Carousel Pavillion! Students can explore and ride in the 1912 CW Parker Carousel and visit with Barnaby, the take-apart carousel horse. They go on a spooky flashlight tour of the Museum's village and Deer Lake Park, which includes a walk around 2 reportedly haunted buildings. Students also learn about Okalla Prison and might try on a guards uniform, see a funny movie in the old time theatre and play with replica toys from the 1900's. The package includes a snack and breakfast.
