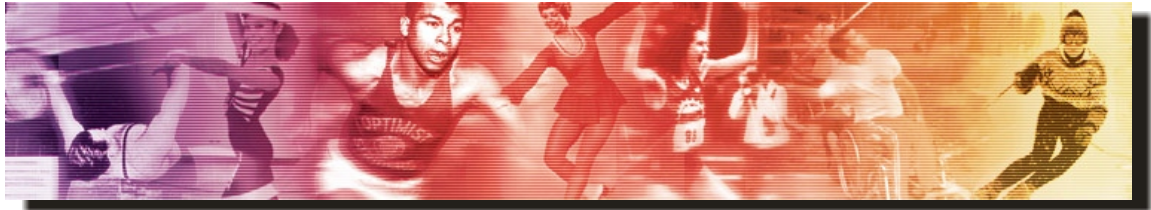

## BC SPORTS HALL OF FAME

Fieldtrips are 2 hours and include time in the Participation Gallery where students can test their own abilities on a running track, climbing wall, multi-sport simulator and more.

BC Sports Hall of Fame fieldtrips are enhanced by incorporating the 'HERO IN YOU' lesson plans in the classroom prior to the fieldtrips.

Designed to help students learn about BC's outstanding sport history and heroes. The fieldtrips use examples set by BC Hall of Famers to illustrate the importance of goal setting, dedication and determination. Field trips are linked to curriculum goals in personal planning, social studies and physical education.

**Olympic Inspirations:** Get ready for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Games by celebrating BC's exceptional olympic history during the Olympic Inspirations School Tour using the Artefact collection and exhibits of over 50 BC medalists.

**Terry Fox Tour:** The fieldtrip highlights the story of the Marathon of Hope and has students learning from the only permanent gallery dedicated to this great Canadian hero.

**Hero in You Tour:** The tour is the ideal way to introduce the BC Hall of Fame to your students and includes a tour of 14 History Galleries focusing on the stories and lessons of our HERO IN YOU athletes: Rick Hansen, Lori Fung, Debbie Brill, etc. Students will learn about the courage to come back (Karen Magnessun) the importance of social responsibility (Daniel Igal) and the power of play (Silken Laumann)

**Big Moments in BC Sport:** This fieldtrip celebrates the big moments (so far) in BC sport history. Students will learn about BC's first and second Stanley Cup victories, Percy Williams' double gold Olympic victory and how this young 18 yr old helped to put Vancouver on the international map., why the '54 miracle mile is considered one of the best sporting events ever, the BC Lion's first ever Grey Cup win, and more.
